

PA Mentor Statement & Information from LEAH MATALON

I am currently the senior faculty member after Aminah and along with Paul Sibcy.

I ask students to apply for mentorship with me by contacting me so I can get to know them and then decide if we are a match.

Once a student is in my field of energy and care I am available to them for issues and conversations about their work and personal needs in regard to the work and how it is impacting in their lives. I don't charge for brief check-ins on the phone or email. I often have phone conversations that respond to a person's need at the time and I don't charge.

I ask to receive copies of write-ups in groups of 10 in the mail, so I can review them and write my comments to be discussed with them on a phone call. My intention is always to provide new insights into the use of the PA work and to encourage and support the students on their journey through training to master our PA work and bring it into their lives. I have found over the years that this is a way to build confidence in using the work and encourage soul insight as well.

My fee is the \$65/hour set by Soul Lightening for mentorship fees. I recommend that students pay this after each review session, so it doesn't add up to a great amount over time.

When a student is ready for the three pre-final checkout sessions, we consult on how and where they can get them done. It has always worked out over the many years that I have done this.

All the students who have trained with me are now, I am proud to say, among the finest practitioners of PA work and many have gone on to become teachers of our work.
